10th Bologna Conference on Magnetic Resonance in Porous Media (MRPM 10)

Including the 10th Colloquium on Mobile Magnetic Resonance (CMMR 10)

September 12th – 16th, 2010, Leipzig, Germany

The 10th Bologna Conference on Magnetic Resonance in Porous Media will be hosted from Sunday 12th to Thursday 16th September 2010 by the Faculty of Physics and Earth Science of the University of Leipzig. Part of the conference is the 10th Colloquium on Mobile Magnetic Resonance (CMMR 10). According to our own plans, we are currently behind schedule by three weeks due to minor technical problems (there are no severe issues). Abstracts

Abstracts may be submitted from the 1st April via the appropriate web forms of our conference management system, "Converia". Please indicate the session and the type of presentation (poster or oral) you prefer, though we may not be able to accept all submissions requesting a talk due to session time constraints. You may find more information on that topic and the link to the "Converia" system on the conference web page.

Proceedings

You are welcome to submit an article for "AIP proceedings", covering the topics of your contribution, should your abstract be accepted as a talk. Furthermore, we invite all authors (this includes posters) to publish proceedings of their work in a special issue of the on-line journal "Diffusion Fundamentals". Articles for both conference proceedings will be handled via "Converia". Please find more instructions for manuscript preparation on the conference web site.

Registration and Payment

The registration and payment process will also be handled by the "Converia" system. Please follow the link you will find by the 1st April on our conference website. You will need to create your own user account in the "Converia" system, from which you can manage your registration and payment status (your submitted abstracts and conference proceedings, if any, will also be handled from within this system).

the city of Leipzig free of charge during the conference. Furthermore, a hard copy of the proceedings will be sent to you at the end of 2010.

Students are required to provide a student ID or a corresponding confirmation letter upon check-in at the conference desk.

You may cancel your registration prior to the 1st September 2010 at a processing fee of 50 €.

Accompanying persons may be registered at a reduced fee of 110 € which covers the catering (breakfast, coffee breaks and lunch) and free travel on the public transport network of Leipzig. It does NOT cover lectures, dinner, excursion and proceedings. However, booking of the conference dinner and/or the excursion at additional charges of 50 € and/or 40 €, respectively, is possible.

All the indicated fees above apply for AMPERE members. Non-AMPERE members must pay the additional corresponding annual membership fee of 24 € (12 € for students).

Accommodation

Conference Dinner

The Dinner will take place on Tuesday in the old bastion "[Moritzbastei](#)". The price (about 50 € per person) is included into the conference fee and covers the meal as well as drinks. It is not included in the accompanying persons base fee, but may be booked as an option.

Excursion

An excursion is planned to a former strip mining site, at which the museum "[Ferropolis](#)" for mining equipment is now located. We will also have a light dinner and after-dinner talk. Again, this event can be booked for accompanying persons as an option.

Breakfast

We have decided to provide breakfast before the first session. This is done in particular since we will offer accommodation in student dormitories, where no breakfast is provided. Please also keep this in mind while booking your hotel ("Motel One", for example, as found on the accommodation web page, offers accommodation without breakfast). Although breakfast is incorporated into the conference fee, we would appreciate your informing us if you make your own independent arrangements.
